David is a biologist, conservationist, writer, publisher, and lecturer. David has spent most of his life studying west coast and arctic wildlife. David received worldwide acclaim for the Live Bald Eagle Video Cam, which he pioneered streaming on the Internet. His current study on The Urban Bald Eagle of Vancouver BC has turned up over 400 nesting pairs in the greater Vancouver area. His studies and travels have taken him to all continents of the world, and he frequently addresses conservation societies on the conservation and creation of better bald eagle habitat.
